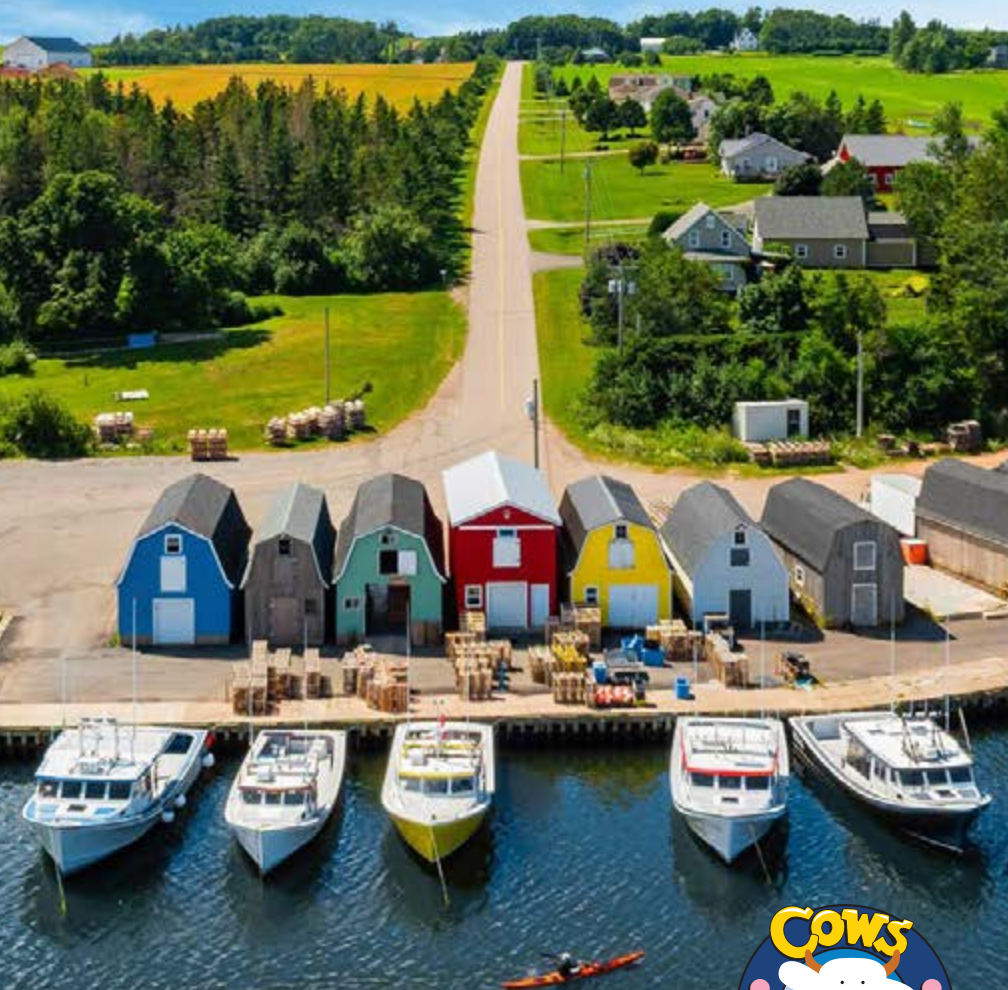

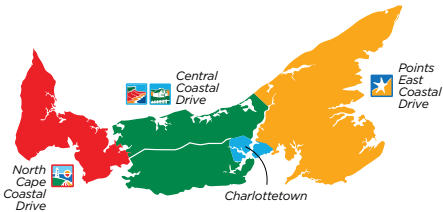
Boasting more than 800 km of shoreline, PEI is yours to explore. We have a number of scenic drives to ensure you don't miss an inch of the Island.

North Cape Coastal Drive is the northwestern part of the Island from Summerside to West Point and North Cape to Cascumpec.

Central Coastal Drive includes two separate drives. **Green Gables Shore** is located on the north side of the province, featuring the Gulf of St. Lawrence's soft sand beaches and Anne of Green Gables. **Red Sands Shore** is located on the south side of the province, with red sandy cliff beaches and the warm waters of the Northumberland Strait.

Points East Coastal Drive covers eastern PEI and features spectacular quiet beaches, small towns and beautiful landscape. Discover the rich history of eastern PEI from Mount Stewart and Elmira to Orwell.

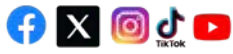

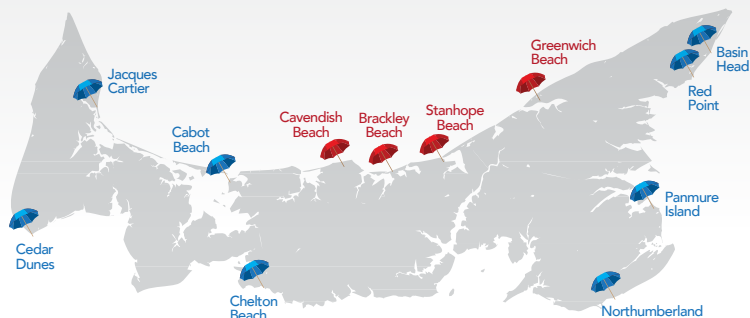

Beach Safety

Super Safety Tips for ALL Swimmers

The beach is one of the most beautiful and fun places to spend time, but it's important to **respect the strength and power of the ocean at all times.**

- Never swim alone.
- Parents, always keep your children at arm's length when in the water.
- Choose a supervised beach.
- Observe surf conditions and follow surfguard advice.
- If waves are present, remember that rip currents are possible.
- **NO POOL FLOATIES. EVER.** Inflatable donuts, loungers, and other recreational floatation toys do not belong in the ocean.

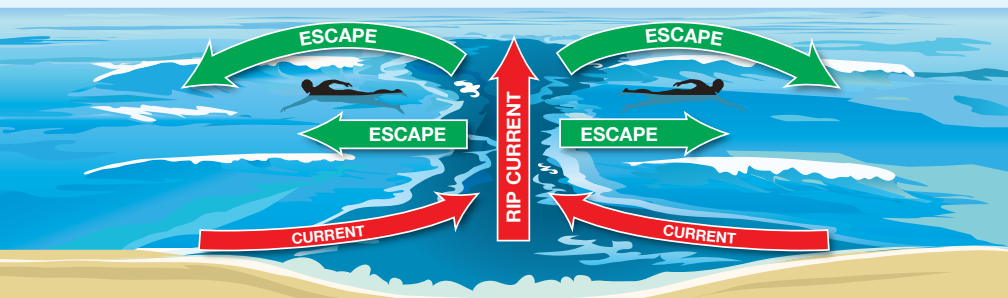
Friendly reminder not to remove or use rescue devices from the beach except in an emergency. These lifesaving tools must remain in place at all times. Taking or misusing them is a crime and could put lives at risk.



Rip Currents

Powerful and fast, rip currents form quickly and can easily overwhelm even the strongest swimmers. They are particularly dangerous since they exist in areas that appear calmer with fewer waves, giving a false impression of safety. If you find yourself being pulled from shore:

- Do your best to stay calm.
- Attract attention. Wave, shout, or whistle, if you can.
- Conserve energy. You can tread water or float on your back. Waves can assist you back to shore.
- Resist the urge to swim directly toward the shore. Instead, swim parallel to it.





MUST-SEE PEI BEACHES

Prince Edward Island is a beach destination with more than 800km of beaches along 1,100km of shoreline. It's the perfect place to experience where the ocean meets the sandy shore. The hardest part of your day might be deciding which beach is right for you!

Basin Head Beach

Run your feet through the sand at Basin Head Beach and it will sing! This beach is one of Prince Edward Island's provincial parks and with that comes all the amenities you could need, including bathrooms and a canteen.

Chelton Beach

Chelton Beach is near the community of Bedeque along the red shore of southwest PEI. It's located within Chelton Beach Provincial Park where you'll find parking, a playground, picnic tables and washroom facilities. Low tide provides the best opportunity for exploring the flats and tidal pools. Watch for crabs underfoot! Fans love Chelton Beach for the warm water, views of Confederation Bridge and low-key vibe.

Greenwich Beach

Greenwich Beach is part of the PEI National Park and is one of those star attractions that Islanders try to keep to themselves. It has the largest sand dunes on the Island with boardwalks and trails that roll across the marshes and grass. The pristine sand seems to go on forever making it paradise for anyone who loves a long walk in the gentle waves.

Jacques Cartier Beach

Jacques Cartier Beach is in Jacques Cartier Provincial Park. This provincial park is near the top of the northern cape of Prince Edward Island. Here, the campsites and picnic tables have unobstructed panoramic views of the ocean. Beach volleyball and horseshoes are beach classics and there's a playground and day use park for picnicking.

Cavendish Beach

This is PEI's most well-known beach in the PEI National Park. Cavendish Beach is miles of white sand surrounded by protected sand dunes. The beach is located right in the heart of Cavendish and is a convenient spot to escape with the family. Explore the walking trails or take part in the captivating interpretive programs on beach ecology and wildlife.



Experience quaint seaside villages, lush rolling farm pastures, a canopy of vibrant orange autumn leaves and of course stunning coastlines.

Whether cycling or on foot, there is simply no better way to take in the Island's beauty than by exploring the Confederation Trail.

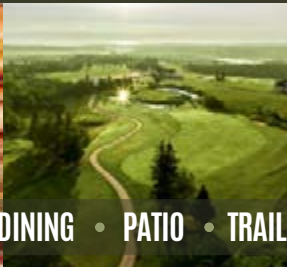

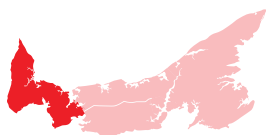


North Cape

North Cape Wind Energy Interpretive Centre

On an Island known for its gentle landscape and soft rounded breeze, how can you resist visiting a place that is all about extremes? Explore the Black Marsh Nature Trail and walk the red sand shore. Indoor exhibits paint a vivid picture of the true power of nature.

Mill River Resort

Now this is a place that knows a thing or two about the good life. Play the 18-hole championship golf course, explore hiking and biking trails and make a splash in the indoor pool. Then sip a pint from the patio overlooking the golf course before you retire to your stylish accommodations.

Bottle Houses

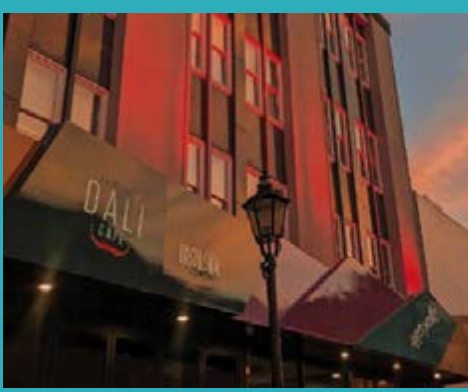

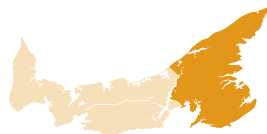

Step back in time with a visit to Roma at Three Rivers National Historic Site where Jean Pierre Roma, a visionary French businessman developed an international trade centre in 1732. Enjoy a delicious home-cooked heritage meal or purchase bread made daily in an outdoor stone oven. Explore trails and gardens to see if you can find the hidden beach.

Bike the Trail

PEI's portion of the Trans Canada Trail is quite special. There are 435km of groomed, well marked trails from PEI's former railway system. Since the conversion from trains to trails in the late 80's, people have been enjoying the Confederation Trail for walking, running and cycling. The trail spans tip-to-tip across the Island, but a popular section is the ride from Mount Stewart to St. Peters. You can't top biking next to the water!

PEI DAY TRIPS

Prince Edward Island is the perfect destination to explore your sense of adventure. So, if you're an outdoor enthusiast, looking to get your blood pumping or simply bonding with friends and family like never before, check out our recommendations to make the most of your Island stay.

St. Peters Bay

Less than 45 minutes northeast of Charlottetown you'll find St. Peters Bay. The scenic Shops at St. Peters Landing offer unique opportunities for shopping and eating. Next, follow road signs to Greenwich, PEI National Park and work off lunch on the extensive trail system. At the end of the trail your efforts are rewarded with the scene of a floating boardwalk leading to a spectacular dune system that rises above the white-sand beach below.

Borden-Carleton and Summerside

Drive 45 minutes west of Charlottetown to Borden-Carleton and get up close and personal with the Confederation Bridge. This engineering marvel spans 12.9km and is the longest bridge in the world over ice-covered water. Shop and eat at Gateway Village. Continue driving west an additional 20 minutes and check out Summerside, the Island's second-largest city. Enjoy a stroll along the scenic boardwalk.



North Rustico

Victoria-by-the-Sea

For a taste of quintessential seaside life on PEI, drive half an hour southwest of Charlottetown to Victoria, also known as Victoria-by-the-Sea. Walk along the harbour, visit the artisan shops and wander the picturesque streets. You won't have to go far to refuel. This postcard-worthy community boasts a number of pubs and eateries, including the popular Richard's Fresh Seafood.

North Rustico

It will take less than 30 minutes to drive from Charlottetown to North Rustico on the north shore, but you will want to spend the day there. Get on the water deep sea fishing aboard a fishing boat. Catch your own fish and enjoy the salt air and stunning views. After lunch, take a stroll along the boardwalk or cross the road to the beautiful sandy beach, part of the PEI National Park. End your day with a feed of fresh lobster at Fisherman's Wharf Lobster Suppers.

North Cape

It's worth the 75-minute drive west of Summerside to the northwestern tip of the Island at North Cape. A stroll along the Black Marsh Nature Trail is an easy 5.5km that brings you along the ridge of the cliffs as the giant windmills look on 80 meters above you. The trail wraps around the northern tip of PEI with 25 interpretive panels detailing the unique plants and wildlife. A visit to the onsite Wind Energy Interpretive Centre outlines the importance of renewable energy and how wind power is harnessed.

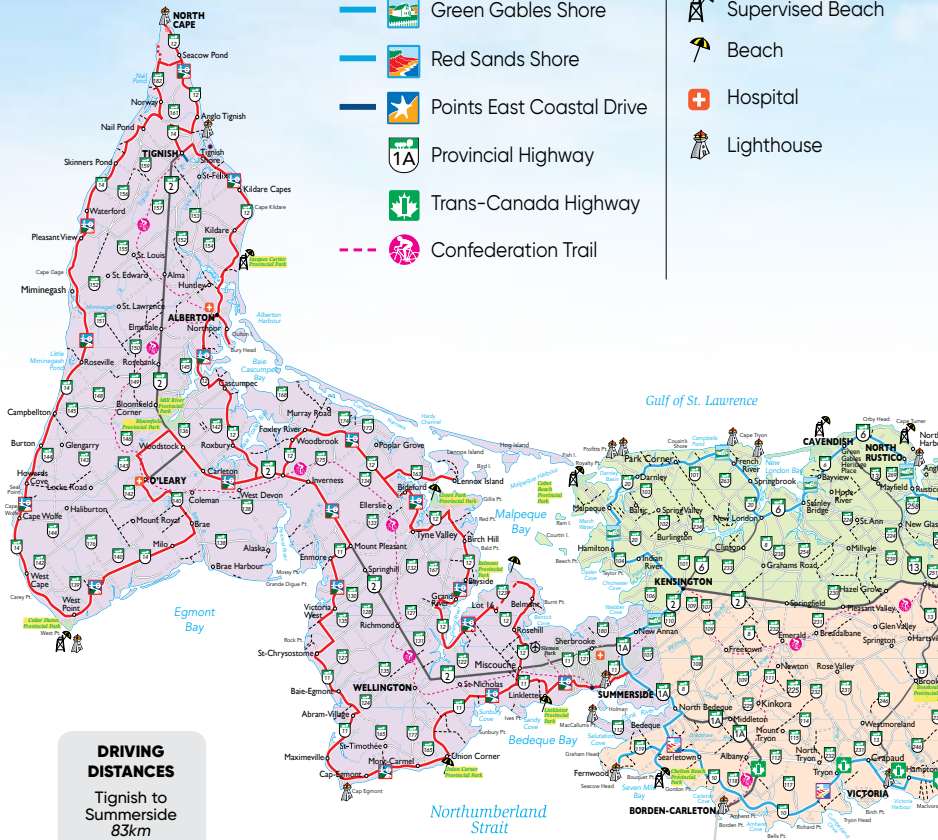

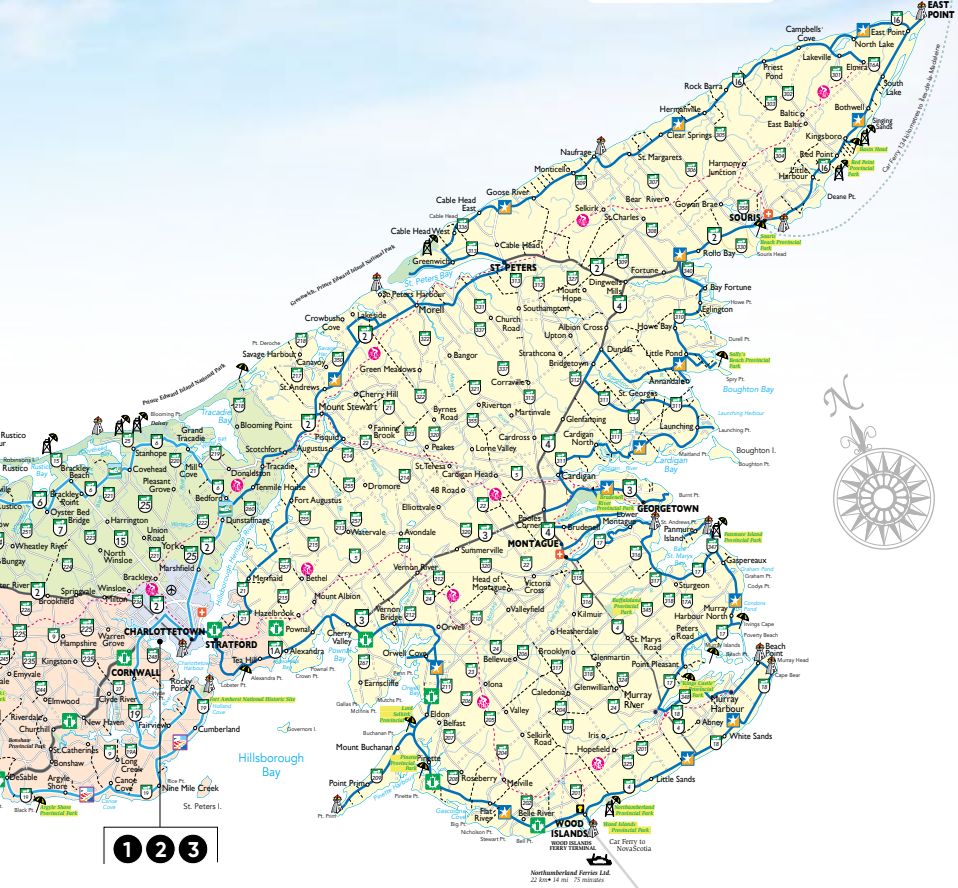
